

Veritas Classical Schools Algebra I Student Supply List - MP 2023 – 2024

- Notebook: 2-inch, 3-ring binder with at least ten tabbed dividers.
- Notebook paper (recommend college ruled); 200 sheets. Do not use spiral notebook paper!
- Blank notebook paper (100 sheets).
- Graph paper, (recommend 4 or 6 squares per inch), 3-hole punched; 50-100 sheets
- Pencils with eraser (mechanical pencils work well)
- Pack of colored pencils (4 or more colors; used for graphing and drawing diagrams)
- Red pen (for correcting homework)
- Ruler or straight edge; protractor
- Dry-erase markers (darker colors preferred) and an eraser.

Scientific calculator

Technically, this Algebra 1 course does not require a calculator. However, the use of a calculator is permitted and will save time on homework exercises.

It is recommended that students have a TI-30 or higher scientific calculator. A graphing calculator is not required for this course, BUT one may be needed for future math classes. Precalculus, calculus and many science courses typically require a TI-83 plus or TI-84 plus graphing calculator. If such courses are in the student's future, you might want to make the investment now rather than having to purchase a second, more advanced, calculator in a subsequent year. You may wish to review the resource lists for advanced math and science classes on the Veritas website before making your selection. Also, you may wish to ensure the calculator is acceptable for the SAT or ACT tests.
