



## Standardized Dress Requirements for 2025-2026

The ultimate goal of the Veritas standardized dress requirement is modesty, neatness, and lack of distraction. Since the time spent in class is limited, we would ask that the dress code not become an issue. If your child arrives at Veritas dressed immodestly or inappropriately, parents will receive a call to bring appropriate clothes to school that day. Please adhere to the requirements stated below:

### General Guidelines for All Students

- **Modesty & Fit:** Clothing should be modest, clean, and properly fitted (not excessively tight or baggy).
- **Length Requirement:** Shorts (boys or girls), skirts, skorts, dresses, and tunics must fall to **at least mid-thigh** (fingertip length).
- **Logos & Graphics:** Clothing must be free of graphic designs, slogans, or images. School and small brand logos are acceptable.
- **Midriffs & Undergarments:** Midriffs and undergarments must not be visible at any time.
- **T-Shirts:** T-shirts may not be worn as outerwear at any time.
- **Sweat Pants:** Sweat pants may not be worn at any time.
- **Hair & Headwear:** Unnatural hair colors are not permitted. Hats are acceptable.
- **Footwear:** Shoe style is left to parents' discretion.

### Girls' Dress Code

#### ▪ K–6th Grade

- Classic polo shirts, blouses, (solid, pinstriped, or plaid) dressy tees (no tank tops)
- Modest, solid-color pants, capris, or mid-thigh length shorts or skorts
- Traditional skirt, jumper, or dress (solid, plaid, or understated print), mid-thigh length or longer
- Leggings may only be worn under dresses, skirts, or tunics that meet length requirements. Leggings may not be worn as pants.
- Shorts or leggings are recommended under skirts/dresses for K–4th girls.
- No athletic wear (tank tops, shirts, athletic skirts, shorts, athletic dresses)
- Solid-color sweatshirts and hoodies with no graphics (school logos and small brand logos acceptable)
- **Jeans are allowed for Elective Classes only** (no holes).

#### ▪ 7th–12th Grade

- Classic polo shirts, blouses, (solid, pinstriped, or plaid) dressy tees (no tank tops)
- Modest, solid-color pants, capris, or mid-thigh length shorts or skorts
- Traditional skirt, jumper, or dress (solid, plaid, or understated print), mid-thigh length or longer
- Leggings may only be worn under clothing that meets length guidelines. Leggings may not be worn as pants.
- No athletic wear (tank tops, shirts, athletic skirts, shorts, athletic dresses)
- Solid-color sweatshirts and hoodies with no graphics (school logos and small brand logos acceptable)
- **Jeans are allowed in all classes** (no holes).

### Boys' Dress Code

#### ▪ K–12th Grade

- Classic polo shirt, Oxford style shirts (solid, pinstriped, or plaid) Collared shirts only **No T-shirts**
- Solid-color sweatshirts and hoodies with no graphics (school logos and small brand logos acceptable)
- Solid-color traditional pants or mid-thigh length shorts (cargo style acceptable)
- **K–6th Grade:** Jeans allowed in Elective Classes only (no holes)
- **7th–12th Grade:** Jeans allowed in Elective and Humanities Classes (no holes)
